The Canterbury Car Club invites interested parties to make application to enter the 2019 SKOPE Classic Race Meeting. This is an annual **invitation event** for drivers who are currently involved in Historic and Classic Car racing.

This is **NOT an entry form**. It is an application by you, to have you and your car considered as entrants. Please note that over 200 competitors have been invited to this year's event. We give preference to competitors who have previously competed at this event and cars with a current MSNZ COD. It is envisaged that there will be limited places available in all classes.

Registration Of Interest forms must be received by Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2018. All forms will be responded to within two weeks of the application being received.

Photographs of the car will need to accompany this application. We require an exterior photograph, showing the livery it would appear at the 2019 SKOPE Classic if accepted. Advertising on classic race cars is limited to a total area of .24 square meters (2 times 600mm by 200mm) unless it is a genuine factory car in original livery. Also required are interior and engine bay photographs.
